Mar Baselios College of Nursing is managed by Mar Baselios Medical Mission Association (MBMMA). MBMMA is under the ownership and auspices of Mar Thoma Cheria Pally. MBMMA is a charitable Trust registered under the Travancore-Cochin Literacy, Scientific and charitable Societies Act XII on 1st January 1977. 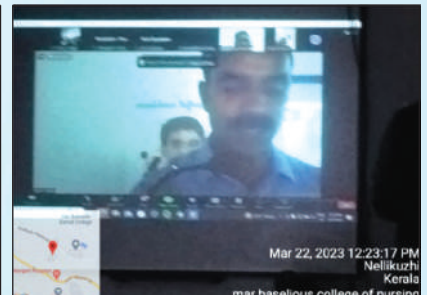
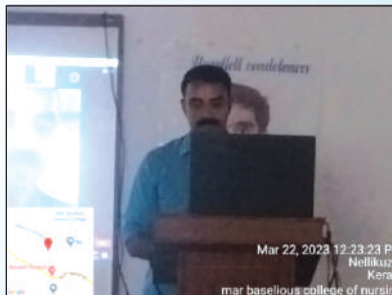
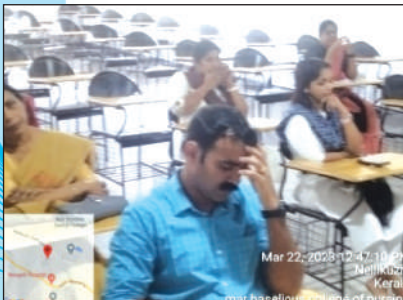
