Mar Baselios College of Nursing is managed by Mar Baselios Medical Mission Association (MBMMA). MBMMA is under the ownership and auspices of Mar Thoma Cheria Pally. MBMMA is a charitable Trust registered under the Travancore-Cochin Literacy, Scientific and charitable Societies Act XII on 1st January 1977. The college is governed by a governing body of 35 members, with his Beatitude Baselios Thomas I, Catholicose of the East, as the President.

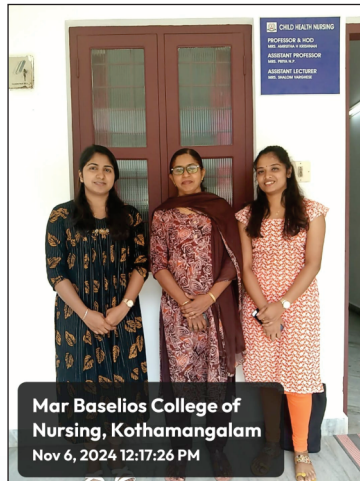
